You may bring your enrolled children and we will provide care for them. Younger babies may stay with you. We will cover volunteer needs for the BHSA Dance Party and the May Faire.



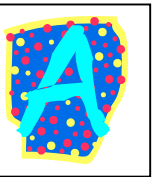
Parent Workday Saturday April 17th 2:00 Pm – 6:00 PM

First Grade News

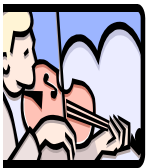
