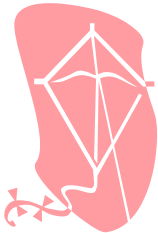

Spring Break Week March 15th – 19th,

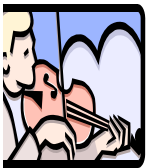
